ANGA 2012

In partnership with ANGA, the SCTE is proud to announce its bursaries for the ANGA Conference and Trade Fair in Cologne, Germany on 12-14 June 2012. The SCTE will be giving away 20 places – each Bursary package includes technical conference registration, economy flights from anywhere in Europe and three nights' hotel accommodation in Cologne.
