Location

Woburn Abbey is easily accessible by road, being just 4 miles west of the M1 between Junctions 12 and 13. There is ample car parking adjacent to the Sculpture Gallery and exact directions will be confirmed with your booking. The nearest rail stations are Bletchley and Milton Keynes (via Euston) or Flitwick (via Kings Cross Thameslink).

Dinner Ticket Prices
