The Kloosterhoeve is a former 13th century farmstead which now houses a brasserie and banqueting rooms. It has recently been extensively renovated, preserving the iconic characteristics of the homestead, but providing the very best of present-day comfort and facilities.

The Kloosterhoeve is renowned for its culinary expertise which is combined with their fabulous hospitality providing an excellent experience for all their guests.

Location

The Kloosterhoeve is ideally located near Utrecht, at the town square of Harmelen. There is ample parking at the Kloosterhoeve adjacent to the building and roadside parking within walking distance. If you are arriving by car the following travel times should be taken into account.
