For 2014, the SCTE has found a completely new venue which is Westminster's best kept secret One Great George Street.

ONE GREAT GEORGE STREET

This is a historic four-domed Grade II listed Edwardian building just off Parliament Square and is the headquarters of the Institution of Civil Engineers. It was built between 1910 and 1913 as the result of an architectural competition won by James Miller, RSA (1860-1947) and the room names have been taken from civil engineering's most important contributors.

During the evening, we will have exclusive use of One Great George Street which includes some stunning rooms, the most magnificent of which is the Great Hall where the main Dinner will be held. This is indeed a totally unique venue and an incredibly special place so, please join us for a memorable evening or perhaps even make a weekend of it in London.



LOCATION

One Great George Street (the home of the Institution of Civil Engineers) is located on the corner of Great George Street and Storey's Gate. The nearest Underground Stations are Westminster and St James's Park which are both within 5 minutes' walk. The nearest mainline stations are Waterloo, Victoria and Charing Cross. Local car parks are provided by Q-Park and are located in Abingdon Street and on the south side of Trafalgar Square.
