The Stadhuis
The beautiful City Hall (Stadhuis) in Gouda is the oldest gothic City Hall in the Netherlands and was built in 1450. It is located at the main square of the city, the Markt, and is one of the best known monuments of Gouda. The architect was Jan III Keldermans, from the famous Flemish Keldermans family of architects, who were also responsible for several other city halls and churches around the Netherlands and Flanders.

The interior dates from the 17th and 18th century and every room in the building, from the basement where meat used to be inspected, to the attic where until recently the City Council met, gives an insight about this town and its people. The various renovations illustrate how fashion and tastes have changed over the centuries.
