FTTH 2013

ANGA 2013

In partnership with ANGA, the SCTE is proud to announce its ongoing bursaries for the ANGA Conference and Trade Fair in Cologne, Germany on 4-6 June 2013. The SCTE will be giving away 20 places – each bursary package includes technical conference registration, economy flights from anywhere in Europe and three nights' hotel accommodation in Cologne. Each package is worth around £800.

IBC 2013

In partnership with IBC, the Society will be awarding three bursaries for the IBC Congress in Amsterdam from 12-17 September 2013. These bursaries will cover economy flights within Europe and hotel accommodation expenses for SCTE members.

Each bursary will provide a full 5-day conference registration, entry to the exhibition and up to £1,000 to cover travel and hotel expenses. This is a unique opportunity for engineers and technicians to hear about the latest developments from the top people in the broadband industry. In addition, the exhibition, the largest of its kind outside the USA, provides a showcase for the latest equipment and ideas.
