The 1st SCTE India 2016 Awards also hosted a powerful panel discussion during the show with Mr. Sanjay Kaul, Cisco; Mr. Vivel Garg; Reliance DTH; Mr. Rajat Nigam, Network 18 and Mr. Sanjay Jain, DEN Networks, to name a few. Important topics addressed during this panel included:

There were two product launches alongside the awards; the first mobile cable wallet by Mimotech and the first loyalty reward for cable operators by Flashpoint India.
